CONSENT ORDER AND REASONS

Under s. 37.1 of the *Health Professions Act*

The Inquiry Committee of the CRNBC considered the Consent Order Proposal (the “Proposal”) submitted by the Former Registrant on August 7, 2015 and attached. The Inquiry Committee noted the Former Registrant’s admissions as set out in the Proposal are of serious misconduct, as the CRNBC must be able to rely upon agreements made with registrants in order to fulfill its mandate to regulate the profession and protect the public. It noted that, regarding another matter, the Former Registrant’s registration was cancelled by decision of an Inquiry Committee Panel dated June 18, 2015. It noted the Registrant’s acknowledgements contained in the Proposal, including that any future application is subject to the requirements of the *Health Professions Act*.

Having reviewed the Proposal and based upon the considerations set out above, the Inquiry Committee makes the following orders:

1. Pursuant to s. 39(8), that the Registrant is not eligible to apply for reinstatement of registration until August 7, 2018, and
2. No costs shall be payable by the Registrant in relation to the Citation or this Proposal.
