TAKE NOTICE that a Panel of the Discipline Committee of the British Columbia College of Nurses and Midwives (BCCNM) will conduct a hearing into your conduct and competence as a Licenced Practical Nurse registrant under s.38 of the *Health Professions Act* (the Act).

The hearing will be either held at the offices of BCCNM, 900 – 200 Granville Street, Vancouver, British Columbia, or be conducted by videoconference, on **December 8 and 9, December 12 to 16 and December 19 to 21, 2022**, commencing at 10:00 a.m.

You are requested to attend the hearing. You have the right to be represented by legal counsel and to submit evidence. However, if you fail to attend the hearing, the Panel will proceed with the hearing in your absence, and, without further notice to you, may take any action that it is authorized to take under the Act.

The purpose of the hearing is to inquire into your conduct as follows:

1. While a registrant of one of BCCNM's predecessor Colleges, the College of Licensed Practical Nurses of BC, you fostered a relationship with BB to advance your personal financial interests and/or engaged in financial exploitation of BB, by doing one or more of the following:
 - a. Between 2014 and 2017, you acted to alienate BB from her friends and family;
 - b. In early October 2016, you attended a branch of the TD Bank with BB seeking to arrange a \$100,000 increase to BB's Line of Credit, without proper regard for BB's best interests;
 - c. On or about June 29, 2017, you attended a branch of the TD Bank with BB seeking to withdraw BB's personal funds, without proper regard for BB's best interests;
 - d. On or about June 26, 2016, you received \$2,000 drawn from BB's Line of Credit account, which was deposited in your account on or about June 27, 2016, without proper regard for BB's best interests;

- e. On or about July 22, 2016, you received \$3,000 drawn from BB's Line of Credit account, which was deposited in your account on or about July 25, 2016, without proper regard for BB's best interests;
- f. On or about October 5, 2016, you received \$5,000 drawn from BB's Line of Credit account, which was deposited into your account on or about October 12, 2016, without proper regard for BB's best interests;
- g. On or about August 1, 2014, receiving a \$1,000 draft drawn from BB's Visa account, without proper regard for BB's best interests;
- h. On or about January 27, 2015, receiving a \$12,000 draft drawn from BB's Chequing account, without proper regard for BB's best interests;
- i. On or about May 17, 2016, receiving a \$2,000 draft drawn on BB's Line of Credit account, without proper regard for BB's best interests;

all of which is contrary to one or more of the following Professional Standards and/or Practice Standards: *Professional Standards, Standard 4: Ethical Practice and Conflict of Interest Practice Standard*, and also constitutes professional misconduct or unprofessional conduct, or breach of the Act or bylaws, under s.39 (1) of the Act.

The Discipline Committee is constituted under the Act and BCCNM's bylaws. You are referred to sections 37 to 40 of the Act, and sections 196 to 213 and Schedules I and J of the bylaws.

FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that after a hearing under s.38 of the Act, the Discipline Committee may make such determinations and orders under s.39 of the Act as it considers appropriate.
