Undertaking not to repeat the conduct

1. Undertakes not to: provide care by text message, share personal information with clients, fail to send required referrals, fail to document client contact and care adequately, or abandon clients.

Remedial activities

2. Complete the following remedial activities;
 - a. BCCNM Professional boundaries in nursing practice learning module for Nurse Practitioners (full module)
 - b. BCCNM Documentation learning module for Nurse Practitioners (full module)
 - c. PROBE Ethics & Boundaries Program – Canada

Reprimand

3. Be reprimanded for providing care by text message, sharing personal information with a client, not sending all required referrals, not documenting client contact and care adequately, and abandoning four clients.

Suspension

4. Be suspended for four days for providing care by text message, sharing personal information with a client, not sending all required referrals, not documenting client contact and care adequately, and abandoning four clients.
