Change	Description	Effective date
BCCNM board approves revision to NP prescribing standard	The limit related to amphetamines and other designated drugs in the Nurse Practitioner Scope of Practice Standards, Limits and Conditions: Prescribing Drugs has been rescinded. This change takes effect immediately and will permit NPs to prescribe amphetamines such as Adderall to their adult clients. Questions?	In effect (Dec 20, 2023)
BCCNM board rescinds limit on NP prescribing of anabolic steroids	NPs can prescribe steroids beyond testosterone. The limit on prescribing anabolic steroids and their derivatives in the NP Scope of Practice: Standards, Limits, and Conditions has been rescinded. Questions?	In effect (Jan 25, 2024)
Editorial updates to NP standard relating to mental health and capacity assessments	 The Nurse Practitioner Mental Health and Capacity Assessment standards, limits, and conditions have been updated.
