

PART 10 - DELEGATION AND STUDENTS

Delegation

- 10-1 (1) The board must, by bylaw, make practice standards authorizing any permitted delegation by licensees of the performance of restricted activities to unregulated care providers under section 74 of the Act, and establishing standards, limits and conditions for such delegation.
- (2) Without limiting subsection (1), a practice standard made under subsection (1) must address the matters described in section 74(3)(a) of the Act.

Students

- 10-2 (1) The board must, by bylaw, make practice standards establishing standards, limits and conditions for licensees to provide regulatory supervision or direction under section 32 of the Act for students enrolled in an education program that is recognized under section 6-6 or deemed to be equivalent to a recognized education program under section 6-10.
- (2) Without limiting subsection (1), a practice standard made under subsection (1) must, for the purposes of section 32(b)(i) of the Act, describe the classes of licensees who are authorized to provide regulatory supervision or direction for students who are in the process of meeting the requirements and conditions for practising licensure in each designated health profession governed by the college.
- (3) For greater certainty, the classes of licensees authorized to provide regulatory supervision or direction for students described in subsection (2) may include one or more classes of licensees of another regulatory college.
