**CONSENT ORDER & REASONS  
under s. 37.1 of the *Health Professions Act***

The Inquiry Committee of the BCCNP (formerly CRNBC) considered the Consent Order Proposal (the “Proposal”) signed by the Registrant on September 23, 2018 and attached. The Inquiry Committee noted that in light of the facts and admissions set out in the Proposal, as well as the Reasons for Decision and Order of the Discipline Committee of the College attached thereto, the disposition in the Proposal is appropriate and in the public interest.

Having reviewed the Proposal and based upon the considerations set out above, the Inquiry Committee makes the following orders:

1. Pursuant to s. 39(2)(c) of the HPA, the Registrant is suspended for a period of six weeks commencing on November 1, 2018 or such other date arranged by the College; and
2. Pursuant to s. 33(7) of the HPA and s. 39(5) of the HPA, the Registrant shall pay costs to the College in the amount of \$12,500 on or before July 1, 2019.
